Chapter 395.

Resolve in relation to the late adjutant general.

Doings of the late adjutant general, investigation of. Resolved, That the attorney general be and he is hereby directed to investigate the doings of James R. Bachelder late adjutant general and acting quartermaster general in relation to the sale, transfer and charges of commission in disposing of military property under the resolve of February twenty-eight, eighteen hundred and fifty-five, and institute such proceedings under the direction of the governor and council as may be deemed expedient.

[Approved April 10, 1856.]
