CHAP. 88.

Chapter 88.

An act to incorporate the Long Reach Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Corporators. SECT. 1. C. L. Owen, D. C. Magoun, John H. Kimball, Thomas M. Reed, B. C. Sewall, William D. Sewall, and J. D. Robinson, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Long Reach Bank.

Corporate name. Capital stock \$100,000. Shares. Location. SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be one hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each ; and said bank shall be located and established at Bath, in the county of Sagadahoc.

Powers, privileges, &c. SECT. 3. The said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and subject to all the restrictions and liabilities thereof.

Chapter 89.

An act to incorporate the Lowell Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Corporators. SECT. 1. Edmund Smith, James Lowell, J. G. Coburn, Timothy Walker, Ebenezer Ham, H. G. Cilley, Mark Lowell, Archibald Wakefield, H. H. Packard, D. M. Ayer, J. W. Perkins, C. Bradley, Carlyle Whipple, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors and company of the Lowell Bank.

Corporate name. Capital stock \$100,000. Shares. Location. SECT. 2. The capital stock of said company shall be one hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and said bank shall be located and established in the town of Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin.

Powers, privileges, &c. SECT. 3. The said corporation are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and subject to all the liabilities and restrictions thereof.
