Resolve in favor of D. B. Hinckley.

D. B. Hinckley, in favor of. Resolved, That there be appropriated out of the treasury of this state, to Daniel B. Hinckley, the sum of eighteen hundred and three dollars and thirty-six cents, which is in lieu of the provision made for said Hinckley by a resolve approved August twentieth, eighteen hundred fifty, and a resolve approved August twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred fifty, both of which last named resolves are hereby repealed. And the aforesaid sum if received by said Hinckley, to be in full for claims of said Hinckley on the state, on account of land conveyed by the state in township number five, range eleven.

Chapter 37.

Resolves for the promulgation of certain laws.

Laws, promulga-

Resolved, That all laws for the charter or incorporation of banking, railroad or insurance companies, or in any way regulating or appertaining thereto, shall be promulgated through the state paper, as public laws are now required to be. And the secretary of state is hereby directed to furnish copies of all such laws, as soon after their passage as may be, to the publishers of the state paper.

Resolved, That this resolve shall apply to all laws of the character described, already passed at this session, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.
