Chapter 57.

Снар. 57.

Resolve relating to the Passamaquoddy Indians.

Resolved, That so much of the resolve, in aid of the Passama- Passamaquoddy quoddy Indians, approved February twenty-six, one thousand eight relation to. hundred and fifty-six, as is amendatory of a resolve approved March sixteenth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Chapter 58.

Resolve in favor of the city of Bath.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury, from any City of Bath, its money not otherwise appropriated, to the city of Bath, sixty-five dollars and eighty-seven cents, for committing to and supporting Jane Sutherland, a foreign insane pauper, in the insane hospital.

Chapter 59.

Resolve authorizing the sale of Indian land in Brewer,

Resolved, That the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians is Indian land, sale authorized to sell the land belonging to said tribe, situated in the town of Brewer; provided, he can obtain the fair value thereof, and deposit the avails in the state treasury, for the benefit of said Indians.

Chapter 60.

Resolve providing for laying a tax on the several counties in the state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties contained in County taxes. the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax for each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied, for the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same, and other purposes ordered by law, to wit: Androscoggin, thirteen thousand dollars; Aroostook, two thousand five hundred dollars;
