**Chapter 63.**

Resolve in favor of S. L. Milliken and S. B. Holt.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of the state, to S. L. Milliken and S. B. Holt, fourteen dollars each, for expenses incurred by them in visiting the state arsenal, at Bangor, by order of the legislature.

**Chapter 64.**

Resolve in favor of Penobscot county.

*Resolved,* That the treasurer of state be directed to pay to the treasurer of Penobscot county, from the Indian fund of the Penobscot tribe, the sum of four hundred dollars, in full for expenses incurred by said county for the support of John Mitchell and John Crow, in house of correction, and commitment thereto; two indigent insane Indians of said tribe, from February fifth, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, to May thirtieth, eighteen hundred and fifty-six.

**Chapter 65.**

Resolve in favor of Warren H. Vinton.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of the state, to Warren H. Vinton, thirty-five dollars, it being for expenses incurred on account of sickness while attending as a member of the house, the present session.

**Chapter 66.**

Resolve in favor of Nathaniel Hanscom.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury, to Nathaniel Hanscom of Lee, six dollars per month, during the pleasure of the legislature, for injuries received while in the service of the state.
