WHITEFIELD .- SOLON .- BATH .- MOSCOW.

Chapter 78.

Resolve in favor of the inhabitants of the town of Whitefield.

Resolved. That there be paid out of the treasury of the state to the inhabitants of the town of Whitefield, the sum of seventy-six dollars and eighty-four cents, for expenses incurred in committing Catharine O'Crilly, an insane state pauper, to the insane hospital, and for her support therein, in the years eighteen hundred and fifty-six and eighteen hundred and fifty-seven.

Chapter 79.

Resolve in favor of the town of Solon.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Solon, from the Town of Solon, in favor of. treasury of state, from any money not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-three dollars, in full for committing Anne and Mary O'Crilley, two foreign insane paupers, to the insane hospital.

Chapter 80.

Resolve in favor of the city of Bath.

Resolved, That there be paid to the city of Bath from the state City of Bath, in treasury, from any money not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fourteen dollars, in full for the commitment of an insane foreign pauper to the insane hospital.

Chapter 81.

Resolve in favor of the town of Moscow.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury, from any Town of Moscow, money not otherwise appropriated, to the town of Moscow, thirtyfour dollars and fifty cents, for commitment of a foreign insane pauper to insane hospital, and incidental expenses.
