### Chapter 121.

Resolve in favor of the town of West Gardiner.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state, be directed to deliver to the clerk of the town of West Gardiner, for the use of said town, volumes thirty-eight and thirty-nine of the Maine Reports; *provided* they be in the library to replace volumes destroyed by fire.

### Chapter 122.

Resolve in relation to printing certain documents.

*Resolved*, That the resolve providing for the printing the lists of stockholders in banks and other corporations, approved April fifteenth, eighteen hundred fifty-seven, also the resolve approved March sixteenth, eighteen hundred fifty-five, be and the same are hereby repealed; *provided*, that this resolve shall not be regarded as reviving any previous resolve providing for printing such lists.
