CHAP. 132.

Chapter 132.

Resolve in favor of Sanford Noble.

Resolved, That there be paid to Sanford Noble, out of any moneys Sanford Noble, in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars and ninety-three cents; the said sum being in full for land to which said Noble was entitled under the treaty of Washington, and entered in the land office to his credit.

Chapter 133.

Resolve in relation to the distribution of a portion of the public lands belonging to the United States.

Resolved, That our senators and representatives in congress, be United States. requested to use their efforts to procure a fair and equitable distribution of a portion of the public lands belonging to the United States, among the several states, for educational purposes.

Resolved, That the governor be requested to transmit to each of our senators and representatives in congress a copy of these resolves.
