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**Chapter 149.**

CHAP. 149.

Resolve in favor of Wingate Bradbury.

*Resolved,* That Wingate Bradbury of Athens be, and hereby is discharged from all liability on a certain note of hand now in the land office, dated September twenty-third, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, for the sum of three hundred and eighty-six dollars and nineteen cents, and signed by Leonard Bradbury as principal, and the said Wingate Bradbury as surety.

**Chapter 150.**

Resolve in favor of Nathaniel Hanscom.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury, to Nathaniel Hanscom of Lee, one dollar per month in addition to what he now receives, for injuries received while in the service of the state.

**Chapter 151.**

Resolve in favor of the committee on state prison.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of the state the sum of eight dollars, to each of the following persons, to wit: John Berry jr., Nathaniel A. Burpee, Charles L. Ring, Warren W. Rice, S. B. Holt, A. H. Estes, Joseph Davis, H. M. Chadbourne, Reuben Oliver, members of said committee, who by order of the legislature, have visited the state prison; said sum being in full for the traveling expenses of said persons in discharging said duty.
