John A. Cleaveland, in favor of.

Chapter 157.

Resolve in favor of John A. Cleaveland,

Resolved, That there be paid to John A. Cleveland, from any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixteen dollars, the same being for service of transportation at the military encampment in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-six.

Chapter 158.

Resolve in favor of Stephen L. Goodale.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury to Stephen L. Goodale the sum of two hundred dollars, it being a balance due him for service as secretary of the board of agriculture in eighteen hundred fifty-six.

[Approved March 19, 1858.]

Chapter 159.

Resolve for the repair of the military road.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to expend the sum of thirteen hundred dollars for the repair of the military road and bridges thereon, as follows: five hundred dollars on the road on township No. 2, range 2; one hundred dollars for the repair of the bridge over Macwahoc stream; five hundred dollars for the repair of the bridge over the Molunkus stream, and two hundred dollars for the repair of the Sunken bridge, so called, on Indian township, all on the military road.

Chapter 160.

Resolve in aid of building a bridge across the north branch of Dead river in the county of Franklin.

Bridge, in aid of building of.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and directed to expend towards the construction of a good and substantial bridge across the north branch of Dead river in the county of Franklin, on or near

Goodale, in favor of.
