Chapter 161.

Resolve in favor of the Passamaquoddy Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended for schooling of Passamaquoddy Indians under the supervision of the school committees of Princeton and Perry, and said committees shall report to the governor and council, specifying the time the schools are kept, number of scholars, and such other matters as they may deem of interest.

Chapter 162.

Resolve relating to taxes of the towns of Hollis and Dayton.

Resolved, That the county commissioners of the county of York, are hereby authorized to abate the sum of two hundred and seventeen dollars and forty-five cents, from the amount assessed upon the town of Hollis, for a county tax, for the year of our Lord eighteen hundred fifty-five, and to assess said sum of two hundred and seventeen dollars and forty-five cents, upon the town of Dayton, for the year of our Lord eighteen hundred fifty-eight, in addition to the sum to be assessed upon said town as its proportion of the county tax for the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.
