**Chapter 174.**

Resolve for the payment of additional roll of accounts number thirty-eight.

Payment of.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, cities, towns and plantations, respectively named in the additional roll of accounts numbered thirty-eight, the sums set against the names of such persons, cities, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of eight thousand nine hundred eighty-two dollars eighty-one cents, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
