**Chapter 175.**

Resolve for the repair of roads and bridges in the county of Aroostook.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be authorized to expend the sums hereinafter named for the repair of the state roads in the county of Aroostook; for the making and repair of the road from number eleven, range five, to Fish river, two thousand dollars; for repairing bridge at Fish river, one hundred dollars; for repairing road from number eleven, range five, to Presque Isle, five hundred dollars; two hundred dollars of which is to be expended if necessary in changing the location of the road around the Fairbanks hill in letter G; for repairing road from letter H, to Violette brook, fifteen hundred dollars; for the road from Masardis to Oxbow, two hundred dollars.

**Chapter 176.**

Resolve for the repair of the road on Indian township.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be authorized to expend the sum of three hundred dollars for the repair of the road over Indian township in the county of Washington.

**Chapter 177.**

Resolve in aid of building a bridge over the Flag Staff stream in the county of Somerset.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be and hereby is authorized to expend the sum of four hundred dollars in building a bridge over the Flag Staff stream in township number four, in the fourth range of townships west of Kennebec river; *provided*, that before the said sum shall be expended, the proprietors, or inhabitants of said township, shall build or cause to be built a good and sufficient bridge across said stream, to the satisfaction and acceptance of the land agent.
