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**Chapter 192.**

CHAP. 192.

Resolve to collect certain securities in the land office.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be directed forthwith to collect all bonds, executions and notes in his office which matured prior to January first, eighteen hundred and fifty-two; and also any interest due on notes dated subsequent to January first, eighteen hundred and fifty-two; and the land agent is hereby directed to withdraw from the office on or before December fifteenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, any note or other security over due six years or upwards, which in the opinion of the governor and council cannot be collected; but any demand so directed to be retired from the funds of the land office, shall first be advertised three weeks successively in the state paper.

**Chapter 193.**

Resolve in favor of Westbrook Seminary.

*Resolved*, That the sum of two hundred dollars annually be appropriated for the benefit of Westbrook Seminary for the term of ten years, and the treasurer of state is hereby required to pay said sum to the trustees of said seminary.

**Chapter 194.**

Resolve for the repair of Mattawamkeag bridge in the county of Penobscot.

*Resolved*, That the land agent be authorized to expend the sum of two hundred dollars for the repair of the bridge at Mattawamkeag Point in the county of Penobscot.
