Chapter 207.

Resolve for the better protection of the records in the land office.

Land office, records, for the protection of. Superintendent of public buildings.

-duties of.

Resolved, That the land agent be required to prepare an abstract of all books, plans, files of papers and other evidence of record used in said land office, and submit the same to the superintendent of the public buildings, at the close of each session of the legislature, taking his receipt therefor, and that said superintendent be required to protect said books, plans, and files of papers carefully in said land office, and deliver them to the land agent at the commencement of each session of the legislature.

Chapter 208.

Resolve in favor of Theodore C. Woodman,

Theodore C. Woodman, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Theodore C. Woodman four dollars, it being deficiency of his pay as a member of the house as made up on the pay roll.

Chapter 209.

Resolve locating and designating certain townships for settlement.

Certain townships, locating and designating for settlement of. Resolved, That the following townships are located and designated for settlement, viz: G range one, L and M range two, and east half of number two range five, and number five range three.

Chapter 210.

Resolve in favor of Nelson Gilkey.

Nelson Gilkey, in favor of. Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Nelson Gilkey the sum of seven dollars, it being for mileage due him and not made up on the pay roll.
