Chapter 25f.

An act to enable the inhabitants of Camden, if they shall so determine, to purchase two hundred copies of Locke's history of said town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The inhabitants of the town of Camden, are hereby authorized and empowered, if they shall think proper, to purchase of John L. Locke, two hundred copies of his history of Camden, to be disposed of as said inhabitants in legal meeting assembled shall direct; and at any legal meeting called for that purpose, said inhabitants may grant and raise such sum or sums of money, as may be necessary to purchase said two hundred copies, to be assessed, collected, procured and paid out in the usual manner of collecting, assessing, procuring and paying out moneys to discharge the ordinary liabilities of towns.

Authorized to purchase John L. Locke's history of town.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.
