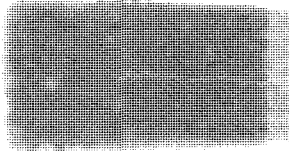

PRIVATE AND SPECIAL LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

Chapter 308.

An act to increase the capital stock of the Long Reach Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Capital stock
increased,
\$5,000.

paid in.

The president, directors and company of the Long Reach Bank at Bath, are hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of said bank five thousand dollars, to be paid into said bank in gold and silver, on or before the first day of October next, and to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each; and loans may be made by said bank on said additional capital whenever the directors or a majority of them, with the cashier of said bank, shall have signed and verified by oath and filed in the office of the secretary of state a certificate that said additional capital has been actually paid in.

Chapter 309.

An act giving additional power to the Penobscot Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Penobscot Mutual Fire Insurance Company is hereby authorized to insure against damage by lightning.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

Chapter 310.

An act giving additional power to the Thomaston Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Thomaston Mutual Fire Insurance Company are hereby authorized to insure against damage by lightning.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.
