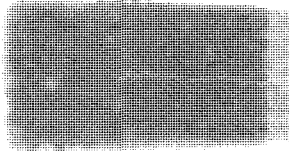

CHAP. 332.**Chapter 332.**

An act to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Proprietors of the Hallowell and Chelsea Bridge Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Act approved
April 14, 1856,
amended.

SECT. 1. The fifth section of said act is hereby amended by striking out in the first line, the word "five" and inserting the word "ten," so that the said section shall read as follows: said bridge shall be erected and completed in ten years from the passage of this act, otherwise this charter shall be void.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 333.

An act to repeal an act entitled "an act additional to an act to incorporate the Maine State Seminary."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Act, approved
March 27,
1858, repealed.

SECT. 1. Chapter two hundred and forty-five of the private and special laws, approved March twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. Three hundred dollars shall be paid out of the state treasury to the trustees of the Maine state seminary on the first day of April, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine; and thirty days after the adjournment of this legislature, a further sum amounting to the interest on ten thousand dollars from said first day of April, until the day when a resolve, approved February fifth, eighteen hundred fifty-nine, authorizing the payment of ten thousand dollars to the trustees of the Maine state seminary shall take effect, shall be paid to said trustees.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.
