

CHAP. 336.

put to the class to which they belong, and the general expenses of the company which do not strictly belong to one class more than to the other, shall be apportioned to each class in proportion to the amount insured in each.

Policies, when to be issued.

SECT. 3. No policy shall be issued by said company until applications for insurance shall have been made to the amount of twenty thousand dollars.

Chapter 336.

An act to incorporate the Camden Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

SECT. 1. David Talbot, H. B. Eaton, Samuel G. Adams, N. T. Talbot, Edward Cushing, E. G. Knight, E. M. Wood, N. B. Jones, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Camden Bank.

Corporate name.

Capital stock, \$50,000.
Shares.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each; and said bank shall be located in Camden, in the county of Waldo.

Rights and privileges.

SECT. 3. The said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and shall be subject to all the liabilities and restrictions thereof.

[Approved March 31, 1859.]

Chapter 337.

AN ACT for the assessment of a State Tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, amounting to two hundred thousand, nine hundred nineteen dollars thirty cents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

State tax, \$200,919 '30.

SECTION 1. That each city, town, plantation or other place hereinafter named, within this state, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged.

SECT. 2. The treasurer of this state shall in the month of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred fifty-nine, send his warrant with a copy of this tax act directed to the mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors, of each city, town and plantation, taxed as aforesaid, requiring them respectively to assess in dollars and cents the sums so charged, according to the provisions of the laws for the assessment of taxes, and to add the amount of such tax to the amount of county and town taxes to be by them assessed in each city, town, plantation or other place respectively.

Treasurer to issue warrant.

SECT. 3. The treasurer in his said warrant shall require the said mayor and aldermen, selectmen or assessors, respectively, to pay or to issue their several warrant or warrants, requiring the collectors of their several cities, towns and plantations, to pay the said treasurer on or before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, the sums against said cities, towns and plantations, respectively, in this act contained; and the said selectmen or assessors, respectively, shall return a certificate of the names of such collectors, with the sum which each may be required to collect, to the said treasurer, some time before the first day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine.

Tax when to be paid into treasury.

SECT. 4. That whenever, for the period of forty days after the time above fixed for the payment of this tax, there shall be any delinquency to pay the same, on the part of the collector of any city or town, it shall be the duty of the treasurer of the state to issue his warrant for enforcing the collection of the same against such collector. The warrant shall be directed to the sheriff or his deputy of the appropriate county, and made in accordance with the laws already existing on that subject, except that it shall be returnable in ninety days from its date; and in addition to the tax itself, it shall require the officer to collect interest thereon at the rate of six

per cent. yearly from the day when the tax became payable, with fifty cents more for the warrant.

Towns precluded from drawing school money, when tax is unpaid.

SECT. 5. That whenever any state tax, assessed upon any city, town or plantation, shall remain unpaid after the pay day appointed therefor, such city, town or plantation is hereby precluded from drawing from the state treasury the school fund, set apart for such city, town or plantation, so long as such delinquent tax shall remain unpaid.

SECT. 6. This act shall be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

An act to incorporate the Trustees of Harpswell Academy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

SECT. 1. Clement Skolfield, J. S. Wyer, John Wilson, N. C. Alexander, Simeon Curtis, Hiram A. Dunning, David S. Dunning, Benjamin P. Dunning, John F. Randall, Charles Dunning, Charles J. Bishop, Clement S. Dunning, John Bishop, Rufus Dunning, Geo. R. Skolfield, Samuel S. Jordan, Abizer Holbrook, second, Robert Pennell, Alcot S. Pennell, Thomas Pennell, Alexander Ewing, Charles Johnson, Henry Barnes, Lemont P. Carr, George L. Williams, Joseph D. Wyer, Clement Skolfield, second, Albert Stover, George S. Dunning, Harmon Pennell and Charles A. Britt, their associates and assigns are hereby constituted a corporation by the name of the Trustees of Harpswell Academy, and by that name may sue and be sued, make such by-laws as they may deem expedient for the management of their affairs in any way not repugnant to the laws of the state, and fill all vacancies occurring in their number, take and hold any estate real or personal which they may now possess, or may hereafter receive by donation or otherwise, the annual income of which shall not exceed the sum of two thousand dollars, said income to be faithfully applied to promote the cause of education, and the corporation aforesaid are invested with all the powers and privileges incident to similar corporations.
