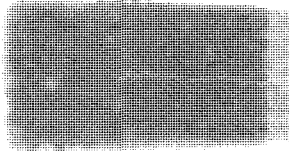

Chapter 349.

CHAP. 349.

An act to make valid the doings of the town of Fairfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The doings of the town of Fairfield at the annual town meeting held in said town on the eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, in relation to re-districting said town for schools, is hereby confirmed and made valid.

Chapter 350.

An act to enable the town of Cumberland to accept the bequests made to said town by the late Eliphalet Greely in his last will, and to carry out the purposes thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The town of Cumberland is hereby authorized, at a legal town meeting called for that purpose, to accept, when the same shall become payable, the bequest or bequests made to said town by the late Eliphalet Greely in and by his last will, upon the terms and conditions and for the purposes therein set forth, and if said town shall so accept said bequest or bequests, said town shall be held responsible, and its faith shall stand pledged, that the same shall be faithfully appropriated in the manner and for the purposes specifically set forth and designated in said will, and especially that said town according to the directions contained in said will shall keep twenty thousand dollars of the amount bequeathed safely invested as a fund, the interest and income of which are to be appropriated to the education of youth, in the manner set forth in said will, and that in the event of any loss to said fund by reason of mismanagement or otherwise, said town shall make good the same, so as to keep the full amount of said fund of twenty thousand dollars at all times unimpaired, and said town is hereby authorized from time to time to raise money by taxation to make good any loss or losses which may occur to said fund as aforesaid in the same manner as assessments are made to pay town expenses.

SECT. 2. Said town is hereby further authorized at a legal town meeting called for that purpose, to empower its selectmen to purchase a lot in said town, of suitable dimensions on which to erect the building for the school contemplated to be established by the
