Resolved, That it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation the necessary blanks to carry into effect the provisions of the foregoing resolves.

CHAP. 293.

Secretary of state to prepare and furnish blanks.

[Approved April 4, 1859.]
