SECT. 9. If the receivers shall neglect to execute or fail to fulfill any of the duties imposed upon them by virtue of the eighth section of this act, the bank commissioners may apply to any judge of the supreme judicial court to revoke the authority of said receivers and appoint others in their stead, and any judge of the court on such application may so revoke the authority of the receivers and appoint others.

SECT. 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 391.

An act to change the names of certain persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Ruel Cunningham of Brooksville, shall be allowed to take the name of Ruel Bakeman ; George Wadsworth of Winthrop, shall be allowed to take the name of George Alvah Wadsworth ; Daniel Green of Waterford, shall be allowed to take the name of Daniel W. Green ; Pennel Salsbury of Trenton, shall be allowed to take the name of Newell Salsbury ; Octavia S. Webb of Troy, shall be allowed to take the name of Octavia Smith ; and Wilmot Webb, son of Octavia S. Webb, shall be allowed to take the name of Frederick Wilmot Smith ; Sylvia M. Burgess of Waterville, shall be allowed to take the name of Sylvia M. Parker ; Harriet A. Young of Belfast, shall be allowed to take the name of Harriet A. Patter-son ; Robert K. Scott, an adopted son of Robert K. Thistleward of Alexander, shall be allowed to take the name of Robert K. Thistle-ward ; Julia A. Warner of East Livermore, shall be allowed to take the name of Julia A. Morrison ; Helen M. Keith of China, shall be allowed to take the name of Helen M. Meigs ; George Alden Lander of Fairfield, shall be allowed to take the name of George Laforest Wheeler.

Names changed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the gov-ernor.
