### PRIVATE AND SPECIAL LAWS

OF THE

## STATE OF MAINE.

March tenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, and for no other CHAP. 413. purpose.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

[Approved March 5, 1860.]

#### Chapter 413.

An act to incorporate the Union Wharf Company in the town of Castine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. William Jarvis, Frederick A. Jarvis, Francis H. Jarvis Corporators. and Rebecca H. Westcott, their associates and assigns are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of the Union Wharf Corporate Company, with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the liabilities incident to similar corporations by the general laws of the state.

Powers, &c.

Sect. 2. The said corporation are authorized to take and hold may hold real any estate real or personal which they now possess in the Union and personal estate. Wharf, so called, extending from land owned by them, into the waters of the Bagaduce river in Castine, and such as they may hereafter receive by purchase or otherwise for the purpose of maintaining said wharf, to an amount not exceeding ten thousand dollars.

SECT. 3. This act shall be in force on and after its approval by the governor.

#### Chapter 414.

An act to incorporate the East Machias Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. Peter Talbot, James O. Robinson, Stephen T. Foster, Samuel W. Pope, B. Thomas Chaloner, Daniel F. Gardiner, Albert P. Cushing, James O. Pope, E. A. Doe, James M. Wiswell, Charles C. Chaloner, James G. Munson, Winslow D. Ramsdell, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the East Machias Manufacturing Com- Corporate pany, with all the powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the duties and liabilities provided in the laws of this state leges, &c.
