SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

Chapter 479.

An act to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

In order to provide for the acts and resolves of legislature requiring the payments of money from the treasury for the current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury ; and the governor with advice and consent

of the council is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of January next to draw his warrant upon the treasury for the same. CHAP. 479.
