Chapter 386.

Resolve on the pay roll of the house.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state to Payment of the several persons named in the foregoing pay roll, the sums set house. against their names respectively, amounting to the sum of twentyseven thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars.
