REVISED STATUTES AMENDED .--- GRAND JURIES.

Chapter 5.

An act to amend chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows:

Sect. 1. Section twelve of chapter eleven of the revised stat-Ch. 11, sec. 12. R. S., amended. utes is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifteen" in the third line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word seventeen. The thirteenth section of said chapter is hereby also Section 13, amended. amended by striking out the word "three" in the second line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word one.

This act shall take effect when approved by the gov-Sect. 2. ernor.

Chapter 6.

An act relating to grand juries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever any justice of the supreme judicial court SECT. 1. shall be satisfied either during the session of court or in vacation that any of the persons returned and acting as grand jurors upon the grand jury in any county have been irregularly drawn or for any other cause are incompetent to act legally on such grand jury, he may discharge such incompetent grand jurors from any further attendance. He shall thereupon transmit a certificate to the clerk of court for such county indicating what persons have been thus discharged and directing the clerk to issue venires for such number of new grand jurors as may by such justice be deemed necessary.

SECT. 2. The clerk of court upon the receipt of such certificate shall record the same upon the records of the court; and shall issue venires for as many grand jurors as such justice has ordered. Said venires shall be served at least four days before the time at -how sorved. which the jurors thus drawn shall be ordered to attend court.

SECT. 3. The jurors thus drawn and notified with such of the original jury as may not have been discharged, if any, shall serve for the remainder of the year for which the grand jury was originally drawn and shall constitute the grand jury with the same powers and duties as if they had been drawn in the manner now provided by law.

SECT. 4. This act takes effect when approved by the governor.
