Chapter 48.

An act authorizing the erection of a dam in the town of Mount Desert, in the county of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows:

SECT. 1. Eben E. Babson, William Kithedge and William S. Richardson, their associates and assigns, be and are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a dam for the purpose of raising a water power to propel the machinery of a saw-mill and other manufactories from the land of Eben E. Babson to land of William S. Richardson, a few rods below the bridge, near the dwelling-house of said Eben E. Babson, in the town of Mount Desert, in the county of Hancock, and to erect and maintain mills and other manufactories.

Authorized to erect a dam.

Location.

The said Eben E. Babson, William Kithedge and Wil- Flood gates. SECT. 2. liam S. Richardson, their associates and assigns, shall always keep good and sufficient flood gates in said dam for the purpose of rafting out and in logs and wood and passing out and in with a gondola at high-water.

Chapter 49. -

An act authorizing the owners of Salt marsh, at the head of Bass harbor, in the town of Tremont, to erect a dam or dyke.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legis*lature assembled*, as follows:

That Eaton Clark, and other owners of Salt marsh, lying at the head of Bass harbor, so called, in the town of Tremont, county of erect dam. Hancock, and their associates, heirs and assigns, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to build, erect and maintain a good and sufficient dam or dyke across said creek, near the bridge or saw-mill near said Eaton Clark's premises, for the purpose of improving said marsh.
