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CHAP. 99.**Chapter 99.**

Resolve in favor of the widow of the late Tristram Redman.

Tristram Redman, widow of, in favor of.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty-six dollars, being the amount to which the late Tristram Redman would have been entitled as a member of the senate at this session had he survived, to be paid to his widow, and that the governor draw his warrant for the same.

**Chapter 100.**

Resolve in favor of the widow of Isaac T. Cole.

Isaac T. Cole, widow of, in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the governor be authorized to draw his warrant on the treasurer for any money not otherwise appropriated, in favor of the widow of Isaac T. Cole, late a member of this house, for the amount that would have been due him for travel and attendance at the present session had he survived, being the sum of forty-two dollars.
