CHAP. 70.

Chapter 70.

An act to amend section forty-six, chapter one hundred and thirteen of the revised statutes, relating to false disclosures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Chap. 113, sec. 46, R. S., relating to false disclosure, amended.

SECT. 1. Section forty-six of chapter one hundred and thirteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by inserting in the third line, after the word "creditor" the words of record or in interest.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the governor.

Chapter 71.

An act to suspend certain provisions in chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes concerning banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Provisions of chap. 47, R. S., suspended.

SECT. 1. The provisions contained in chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes, imposing penalties and liabilities upon banking corporations and stockholders therein for refusal to redeem their bills, checks or drafts in specie, are hereby suspended until the tenth day of January next; *provided however*, that if before that time the Boston banks shall resume specie payments, then in that event the banks in this state are to resume also, any thing in this act to the contrary notwithstanding.

Proviso.

Bills, &c., how paid during suspension.

SECT. 2. During the suspension authorized in the preceding section, said banking corporations shall upon demand pay or tender payment of their bills, checks or drafts in such bank bills as are at the time received as currency by the banks in Boston at their par value.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect forthwith upon its approval by the governor.
