Chapter 153.

CHAP. 153.

An act to change the time of holding the May term of the supreme judicial court in Knox county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The supreme judicial court shall be holden on the second Tuesday of May, annually, at Rockland, within and for the county of Knox, instead of the first Tuesday of May, as is now provided by law.

Time changed for holding S. J. C. in Rockland.

SECT. 2. All matters pending in, or returnable to said court, and which would but for the provisions of this act, have day at the term of said court to be held on the third Tuesday of May of the present year, as by law provided, shall be returnable to and have day at the term of said court, to be held on the second Tuesday of May of the current year.

Matters pending, when returnable.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on approval by the governor.

[Approved March 19, 1862.]

Chapter 154.

An act to change the time of holding the May term of the supreme judicial court in Lincoln county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The supreme judicial court shall be holden on the third Tuesday of April, annually, at Wiscasset, within and for the county of Lincoln, instead of the first Tuesday of May, as is now provided by law.

Time changed for holding S. J. C. at Wiscasset.

SECT. 2. All matters pending in or returnable to said court, and which would but for the provisions of this act have day at the term of said court to be held on the third Tuesday of May of the present year as by law provided, shall be returnable to and have day at the term of said court to be held on the third Tuesday of April of the current year.

Matters pending, when returnable.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on approval by the governor.
