Chapter 116.**CHAP. 116.**

An act to incorporate the town of Sherman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The plantation hitherto known by the name of Golden Ridge, in the county of Aroostook, bounded southerly by Benedicta plantation, easterly by number three range four, northerly by Crystal plantation, and westerly by township three range six, be and hereby is incorporated into a town by the name of Sherman ; and the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges and immunities which the inhabitants of towns within this state do or may by law enjoy.

Sherman, town of, to incorporate.—boundaries.

Powers, privileges, &c.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within said county is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he shall appoint, to choose such officers and transact such business as other towns are empowered to do at their annual town meetings.

First meeting, how called.

SECT. 3. Said town of Sherman shall be entitled to vote in the choice of a representative to the legislature of this state, in the same district and in the same manner as it was allowed and authorized to do previous to the passing of this act, and shall continue a part of the aforesaid district until otherwise provided by law.

Representative district.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force when approved by the governor.

Chapter 117.

An act to incorporate the Naples Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Washington Bray, Josiah Leavitt, Lyman Hall, H. O. Knight, Augustine Chaplin, Joshua Goodridge, Enoch Gammon, Benjamin F. Wentworth, Charles Goodridge, Arthur Gray, Eben Choate, George Hoyt, Joseph Martin, John G. Cannell, Edward Richardson, John Lamb, Nathaniel H. Lawrence, Charles M. Staples and Zebulon Jackson, their associates and successors, are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Naples Mutual Fire Insurance Company, with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all the duties and liabilities, prescribed in the laws of the state relating to similar corporations.
