**Chapter 195.**

CHAP. 195.

An act to require the treasurer of the county of Knox to pay certain money to the treasurer of the county of Lincoln.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The county treasurer of the county of Knox, shall on demand, pay to the treasurer of the county of Lincoln, the amount of money due to the said county of Lincoln under the provisions of the acts incorporating the county of Knox, chapters one hundred and forty-six and one hundred and eighty-one of the public acts of eighteen hundred and sixty.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

**Chapter 196.**

An act to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. In order to provide for several acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money from the treasury, and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury ; and the governor, with advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of January next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury for the same :

CHAP. 197. SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor.

### Chapter 197.

An act for the assessment of a state tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, amounting to four hundred thirteen thousand seventy-four dollars forty-one cents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. That each city, town, plantation, or other place hereinafter named, within this state, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged.
