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Chapter 105.

Resolve assuming the assessment, collection, and payment of the direct national tax.

WHEREAS, the senate and house of representatives of the United Preamble. States of America in congress assembled, did, on the fifth day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, in an act entitled a "bill to provide increased revenue from imposts, to pay the interest on the public debt and for other purposes," assess a tax of four hundred twenty thousand eight hundred twenty six dollars upon this state, that sum being Maine's proportion of the direct tax of twenty millions assessed upon the United States. and.

WHEREAS, said act provides that upon such part or parts of said sum. tax as shall have been actually paid into the treasury of the United States, on or before the last day of June in the year to which such payment relates, shall be entitled to a deduction of fifteen per centum, provided, the state shall give notice by the governor to Provise. the secretary of the treasury, on or before the second Tuesday of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, of its intention to assume, assess, collect, and pay into the treasury of the United States, the tax so assessed, therefore,

Resolved, That the governor of this state be authorized and requested to notify the secretary of the treasury of the United States, that the state of Maine will assume, assess, collect, and pay into the treasury of the United States, the sum apportioned to this state, in said act of August fifth, eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

Chapter 106.

Resolve to amend chapter one of the resolves of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty one, entitled "resolve to encourage the completion of the detailed survey of the state and the publication of a large, new township map of Maine, on the basis of such survey ;" approved January third, eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

Resolved, That the word "eighteen" in the twenty-fourth line of chapter one of the printed resolves of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, be stricken out and the word, twelve be inserted in its stead.
