CHAP. 160. Appropriation.

for the same, at an expense not to exceed one hundred dollars, which sum is hereby appropriated for the purposes named.

Number of copies limited, &c.

Resolved, That the number of printed copies of said digest for which the state shall be held to pay, shall not exceed two hundred; thirty of which shall be substantially bound for the use of the executive and legislative departments.

#### Chapter 160.

Resolve to provide for the distribution of the eighth annual report of the superintendent of common schools.

Report of supt. of common schools, for the distribution of. Resolved, That the superintendent of common schools be authorized and directed to distribute through the members of the present legislature, three copies of the eighth annual report of the superintendent of common schools; for the superintending school committees or supervisors for each of the several cities, towns and plantations of the state.

#### Chapter 161.

Resolve relating to auditing pension claims.

Pension claims, for the payment of.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized to audit and pay any claim for pensions that may arise under chapter sixty-three of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, approved April twenty-fifth one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one; and the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated from any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated; and this resolve shall be in force till the first Wednesday in January next.
