Chapter 156.

An act to continue in force the provisions of chapter seventy-one of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-two, concerning the suspension of specie payment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter seventy-one of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled "an act to suspend certain provisions in chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes concerning banks," is hereby continued in force until the fifteenth day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and this act shall be in force on and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 157.

An act to amend "an act in aid of the families of volunteers," approved March eighteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In lieu of the treasurer of state issuing scrip as provided in section four of said act, he is hereby authorized and directed to pay in money on the first day of March, to the cities, towns and plantations the amount due to each respectively.
