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PUBLIC LAWS

1863.

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SECT. 2. Any real estate held by an executor or administrator in mortgage or taken in execution may be sold at any time before the right of redemption is foreclosed, in the same manner as the personal estate of a deceased person may be sold by an executor or administrator at common law.

CHAP. 213.

Real estate,  
when may be  
sold.

SECT. 3. Any sales of such interests which have heretofore been made in the manner prescribed by the foregoing section shall be deemed valid.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 213.

An act additional relating to foreign insurance companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Any foreign insurance company which shall fail to publish a statement of its condition as required by the sixty-seventh chapter of the public acts of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, shall be liable to a penalty of one hundred dollars for every such failure or neglect, to be recovered in an action of debt, one half to go to the state and one half to the party suing.

### Chapter 214.

An act to amend chapter sixty-one of the revised statutes, relating to the rights of married women.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. Chapter sixty-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "conveyance" in the eighth line of the first section thereof the words: excepting, however, real estate conveyed as security to the wife for any bona fide debt due her from the husband, or for the payment of money actually loaned by the wife to the husband.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.
