CHAP. 207.

Chapter 207.

An act authorizing the county commissioners of the county of Hancock to reassess certain taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Authorized to reassess taxes on certain islands, &c.

SECT. 1. The county commissioners of the county of Hancock at their next session after the passage of this act, are hereby authorized to reassess upon the unincorporated islands, tracts and townships of land, situated in said county, the several amounts assessed thereon by the commissioners of said county in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two, as their proportion of the ordinary county expenses of that year, the treasurer of said county having failed to certify the same seasonably to the state treasurer, and the taxes hereby authorized to be reassessed, shall be collected according to the provisions of the one hundred and thirty-third chapter of the laws of Maine, approved August fourteenth, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, and of the eighty-eighth chapter of said laws, approved August eleventh, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, so far as the same are now in force, without reference to the month in which said taxes may be reassessed.

SECT. 2. The taxes hereby authorized to be reassessed, shall be certified to the treasurer of state in like manner as is now provided by law.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 208.

An act to legalize the doings of school district number four in the city of Calais, and to authorize said district to borrow money for certain purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Certain doings of, made valid.

SECT. 1. The doings of school district number four in the city of Calais, at a meeting thereof held on the eighteenth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty, authorizing their agent to borrow a sum of money not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars to meet the current expenses of the district, to pay existing liabilities, to paint the school-houses in said district together with the academy, and to make all necessary repairs on the same, and the doings of the agent of said district pursuant thereto in borrowing money and giving therefor the notes of the district, are hereby made valid and binding.
