CHAP. 221.**Chapter 221.**

An act to amend an act to incorporate the city of Lewiston, approved March fifteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Sect. 11, act of
incorporation
amended.

SECT. 1. Section eleven of an act to incorporate the city of Lewiston, approved March fifteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, is hereby amended in the seventeenth line by inserting after the word city, the words, and exclusive jurisdiction for the trial of all criminal offences committed in said city, cognizable by a trial justice, provided that it may be lawful for the trial justices in said county to receive complaints and grant warrants for such offences, to be made returnable before the judge of said police court.

Section 12,
amended.

SECT. 2. Section twelve of said act is hereby amended in the eleventh line by adding thereto after the word costs, the words, except in cases hereinafter mentioned, to wit: said judge may demand and receive one dollar for every warrant issued by him, and one dollar for the trial of the issue in each criminal and civil action, and one dollar additional for each day the trial may continue beyond the first.

Section 21,
amended.

SECT. 3. Section twenty-one of said act is hereby amended in the eighth line by inserting after the words "and fifteen councilmen" the words, and a judge of the police court.

Section 25,
amended.

SECT. 4. Section twenty-five of said act is hereby amended in the third line by inserting after the word "youth" the words, and of the amendments thereof and acts additional thereto, and of an act respecting school district number two in Lewiston, approved March six, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty. And said section is further amended by adding thereto the words, and the terms of office of the school officers of such districts shall continue until other officers shall be appointed in their places and no longer.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect on its approval by the governor.
