Chapter 200.

Resolve in favor of Amos M. Roberts, assignee of Franklin Adams.

Resolved, That the time for taking off timber from township numbered three, in the fifth range, north of Bingham's Kennebec Purchase, specified in a resolve approved March fourteenth, eighteen hundred sixty-one, is hereby extended to the assignee or legal representatives of Franklin Adams, for the term of two years after the present logging season.

Chapter 201.

Resolve in favor of Margaret M. Darling.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Margaret M. Darling lot numbered seventy-nine, in township numbered six, range five, west east line state.

Chapter 202.

Resolve in regard to trespassers on the public lands.

Resolved, That the land agent be directed to enforce the laws against trespassers on the public lands, against parties who may take off, under pretence of having been permitted, timber of a different kind from any specified in such permits.
