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**Chapter 218.**

**CHAP. 218.**

Resolve allowing the right to cut spruce lumber on the state land in township number six, range six, west east line state.

*Resolved*, That Samuel B. Gilman, successor to Eliphaz Gullifer and Orlando W. Gilman, be allowed to cut twelve hundred thousand feet of spruce lumber on the state's land in township number six, range six, west east line state, within the time limited for cutting the same quantity, as provided in resolve approved March eleventh, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, entitled "resolve in favor of Eliphaz Gullifer and Orlando W. Gilman," and this resolve shall be accepted in lieu of and in full satisfaction for the quantity of spruce lumber contemplated in the resolve approved March eleventh, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one.

**Chapter 219.**

Resolve for the benefit of the town of Jackson.

*Resolved*, That the account of the town of Jackson in aid of the families of volunteers, be allowed to go before the governor and council, under the resolve of the legislature extending the time of receiving such accounts.

**Chapter 220.**

Resolve providing for the distribution of the act relating to town bounties.

*Resolved*, That the secretary of state be instructed to cause one thousand copies of the act entitled an "act to make valid the doings of cities, towns and plantations, in raising bounties and for other purposes," to be printed, and one copy to be sent by mail to all the mayors of cities, selectmen of towns, and assessors of plantations in the state, as soon as may be, and the remainder be distributed to the members of the legislature.
