Chapter 229.

CHAP. 229.

Resolve authorizing the conveyance of the state's interest in certain lots of land originally sold to William Cummings.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to confirm to the legal claimants under William Cummings, the title to lots numbered one, three and four in the town of Ashland, in the county of Aroostook, upon due proof that the persons claiming said lots, or either of them, claim title thereto from said Cummings.

Chapter 230.

Resolve in favor of the heirs at law of Catharine T. Tuthill.

WHEREAS, The land agent, on the thirtieth day of April, eighteen hundred and fifty, sold and deeded to Catharine T. Tuthill, four thousand acres of land in township numbered one, range six, in Franklin county, which deed was duly recorded in the land office, but was lost before being recorded in the registry of deeds for said Franklin county; therefore,

C. T. Tuthill, heirs of, in favor of.

Resolved, That a copy of said deed, duly certified by the land agent, may be used in any court as evidence of such title, and the register of deeds for Franklin county where said land is situated, may record said copy as if it were the original deed, and full credence shall be given to such record.

Chapter 231.

Resolve authorizing the land agent to convey certain lots of land to Sarah M. Churchill.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to convey to Sarah M. Churchill, lots numbered one, section six, and numbered one, section five, in the town of Washburn, in the county of Aroostook; the conveyance is to be unconditional and no further requirements shall be made for settling duties or road labor upon said lots.
