Chapter 253.

Resolves in favor of the state prison.

State Prison, for debts, in favor of. Resolved, That the sum of eleven thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the payment of the indebtedness of the state prison, to be paid out under the direction of the governor and council.

-for sub officers, in favor Resolved, That the sum of six thousand nine hundred and twenty-five dollars for the payment of subordinate officers and other expenses for the current year, is hereby appropriated and placed at the disposal of the governor and council.

Chapter 254.

Resolve to amend a "resolve" in favor of certain banks of the state of Maine.

Resolve approved Jan. 30, 1863, amended. Resolved, That the resolve entitled "resolve in favor of certain banks of the state of Maine," approved January thirty, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, be amended by striking out the words, "Marine Bank" and insert in lieu thereof, the words, Maine Bank, Brunswick.

Approved March 20, 1863.

Chapter 255.

Resolve in favor of state reform school.

State reform school, in favor Resolved, That the sum of twelve thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the support of the reform school for the financial year ending April first, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and no further sum shall be drawn from the treasury therefor during said year.

Chapter 256.

Resolves repealing resolves in favor of Alexander G. Turner and Charles U. Buckmar.

Resolve in favor of A. G. Turner, repealed.

Resolved, That the resolve in favor of Alexander G. Turner, approved March twenty-three, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, be and the same is hereby repealed.
