Chapter 267.

CHAP. 267.

Resolve locating and designating certain lands for settlement.

Resolved, That township C, range two, west from the east line of the state is hereby located and designated for settlement.

Lands designated for settlement.

Approved March 24, 1863.

Chapter 268.

Resolve in favor of W. H. McCrillis.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to William H. McCrillis one hundred and sixty-one dollars and ninety-five cents being the amount and interest paid by said McCrillis to the state for taxes assessed on the south half of township numbered two in the third range of townships west from the east line of the state in the county of Aroostook, which land at the time of the assessment of taxes was the property of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant in payment of the same; *provided* a release of the tax title is first made to the state.

Chapter 269.

Resolve authorizing the purchase of twenty-five copies of the revised statutes.

WHEREAS, The state has occasion year by year to use from thirty to forty copies of the revised statutes to supply the wants of the legislature, the different departments of the government, newly incorporated towns and newly organized plantations; and whereas the supply on hand at this time belonging to the state is less than thirty copies; therefore,

Preamble.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be and he is hereby authorized and directed to purchase for the use of the state of H. L. Davis of Portland, at a price not exceeding three dollars per copy, twenty-five copies of the revised statutes and that the sum of seventy-five dollars be hereby set apart from any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to pay for the same.
