Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to pay a man to superintend the farming interests of Penobscot Indians.

Resolve to sustain the national government.

Resolved, That in the present crisis of our country there is no choice but to sustain the constituted authorities or to submit to armed traitors.

Resolved, That in order to put down the rebellion, the people will sustain the government of the United States with all the resources at their command.
