Chapter 292.

An act to provide for an additional term of the court of county commissioners for the county of Knox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. There shall be a term of the court of county commissioners for the county of Knox holden annually on the fourth Tuesday of January.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 293.

An act to change the name of the Maine State Seminary to that of Bates College, and to otherwise alter the charter of said corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Maine State Seminary, an institution of learning for males and females, located in Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin, shall hereafter be called and known by the name of Bates College; and the act incorporating the said seminary, entitled "an act to incorporate the Trustees of the Maine State Seminary," approved March sixteen, eighteen hundred fifty-five, is
