Clark, for the said sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars, and CHAP. 291. upon the execution of such bond or obligation.

Approved February 17, 1864.

Chapter 291.

Resolve in favor of Henry Burns.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury from the state Henry Burns, school fund for the present year to Henry Burns of Long Island plantation, in the county of Hancock, the sum of twenty dollars, it being the amount of said fund due his four scholars who have not been included for the last six years in the number of scholars returned to the state from said plantation.

Approved February 17, 1864.

Chapter 292.

Resolve establishing a valuation of certain towns and plantations in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the number of polls and amount of estates hereto Valuation of annexed to the several towns and plantations in the county of Aroostook, are hereby established as the true number of polls and valuation of estates of taxable polls and estates in said towns and plantations, until the further order of the legislature. Returns of said polls and estates having been made to the state treasurer under an act approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-two. ø
