Chapter 369.

Resolve in favor of Stevens and Savward.

Stevens & Sayward, in favor of. Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Stevens and Sayward, for furnishing two hundred and fifty-three copies of the daily Kennebec Journal, on order of the legislature, and for advertising in the same, notices of legislative committees, five hundred and sixty-six dollars.

Approved March 25, 1864.

Chapter 370.

Resolve in favor of Houlton Academy.

Trustees of Houlton Academy, in favor of. Resolved, That the state treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay to the trustees of Houlton Academy, the sum of two thousand dollars, for the use and benefit of said academy, from the funds arising from the sale of timber and lumber, under a resolve of the present legislature appropriating the timber and lumber on a township of land for educational purposes; said sum of two thousand dollars to be deposited in the treasury of the state, the interest only to be paid annually to the trustees of said academy.

Approved March 25, 1864.
