### Chapter 322.

An act to increase the salary of the register of probate for the county of York.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. That the salary of the register of probate for the county of York, shall be nine hundred dollars instead of the salary now register of probate Y established by law, commencing on the first day of January, in the 60., \$900. year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Approved February 24, 1865.

### Chapter 323.

An act to increase the salary of the judge and register of probate for the county of Aroos-

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. From and after the thirty-first day of March, eighteen Salary of judge hundred sixty-five, the salary of the judge and register of probate for the county of Aroostook, shall be three hundred dollars each, took county, instead of the sums now allowed by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

### Chapter 324.

An act to simplify indictments for perjury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. Indictments against persons for committing perjury before any court or tribunal, drawn substantially as hereinafter indictment for provided, shall be deemed sufficient in law, viz:
