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RESOLVES

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

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May dividend; three hundred dollars for the November dividend; three hundred dollars to be distributed to the distressed poor of said tribe; the foregoing sums to be paid out of the interest accruing upon the funds belonging to said tribe; three hundred dollars for agent's salary; four hundred dollars for agricultural purposes; four hundred dollars for bounty on crops, for the year eighteen hundred sixty-five; fifty dollars to purchase wood at Pleasant point; fifty dollars for salaries of governors Neptune and Francis, twenty-five dollars each; and one hundred dollars for plowing at Pleasant point and at Peter Deny's point, fifty dollars at each place.

### Chapter 408.

Resolve in relation to the assumption of the war debts of the several states by the United States.

*Resolved*, That in the judgment of this legislature, the war debts of the several states should be ultimately assumed by the United States; and that the efforts of honorable James G. Blaine, one of the representatives in congress from this state, and others to this end meet our cordial approbation.

*Resolved*, That a copy of this resolve be forwarded by the secretary of state to each of our senators and representatives in congress.

### Chapter 409.

Resolve relating to an Agricultural College.

*Resolved*, That our senators in congress be instructed and our representatives be requested to use their efforts to procure an extension of the time during which this state may establish an Agricultural College, as contemplated by a grant of land by congress for that purpose, and a copy of this resolve be forwarded accordingly.
