Chapter 413.

CHAP. 413.

Resolve in favor of the committee on education.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state, the sum of forty-eight dollars to defray the expenses of the visit to Farmington, made by the committee on education under an order of the present legislature.

Chapter 414.

Resolve in favor of Ezekiel Holmes and C. H. Hitchcock.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to the widow of the late Ezekiel Holmes, and C. H. Hitchcock, the sum of three hundred and thirty dollars; being for services rendered the state in making a scientific survey in the years of eighteen hundred and sixty-one and eighteen hundred and sixty-two, and that the governor be authorized to draw his warrant on the treasurer for the same.

Chapter 415.

Resolve in favor of the insane hospital.
